### **Research project leadership**

**National REIN registry** – A national registry including all patients on replacement therapy

(dialysis or transplantation) for kidney failure in France. Design and scientific valorisation of the registry and member of the national coordination from 2002 to 2016.

**NephroTest** – Cohort study of over 2,000 adult patients included from 2000 to 2012 with chronic kidney disease stages 1 to 5 from all causes and followed until Dec 31, 2013. All patients have extensive work-up at baseline with measured GFR. **Principal investigator**

**CKD-REIN** – Funded by the national *Cohort-Investment for the future* program (PIA1). Cohort study including 3,000 adult patients with CKD stages 3 and 4 selected from 40 nationally representative nephrology clinics between 2013 to 2015. Extensive data collection and biobank. 5-year follow-up until Dec 31, 2020. **Principal investigator**.
